

# **Business Innovation Programs - Fact Sheet**

Output, outcome and impact for time period 2006 – August 2019:

<u>Student Enterprise Program</u> (a one year program where students develop a business idea into a realistic business plan with real products/services, marketing material etc. for fair presentations and finally closing of businesses with financial and narrative reporting):

- Approximately 16.000 students participated in BiH, Croatia, Serbia and Kosovo.
- Approximately 4.000 student enterprises have been established and closed and 400 teachers have been trained in accordance to BIPs modular training model in the above-mentioned countries.
- In Bosnia Herzegovina this program is from 2016 implemented in the vocational secondary schools with 16.000 students participating per year.
- A one-year pilot program was launched in Iraq in 2017 including 20 schools, 40 teachers and 800 students.

<u>Start Your Business/Business Plan Development</u> (a program for training of potential entrepreneurs / male age group 18 - 35 / women all ages) where BIP has been involved and contributed to start up and registration of around **9.000 companies**:

- 375 in Iraq 2008 2011
- 8.366 in Iraq 2012 August 2019
- 359 in West Balkan countries (Bosnia Hercegovina, Kosovo and Serbia).

In Iraq this program has been offered to following target groups:

- Entrepreneurs in general in cooperation with the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs
- Female entrepreneurs in cooperation with the local NGO ALOLA and the Ministry of Youth & Sport and the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs.
- Refugees from Syria and Iraqi IDPs in cooperation with the NGO Public Aid Organization (PAO) with main office in Erbil, Iraq.

<u>Growth Program</u> (a three -four months program for companies operating a year or more and with a potential for growth/export):

- 26 companies in Serbia;
- 51 companies have finished the process in Bosnia Hercegovina (BiH).
- 24 certified Growth Trainers in Iraq. The aim is to establish 12 Business Centers/Incubators. Three has started by August 2919.

<u>Cross border Summer Camp</u> (a yearly camp organized for the overall winning companies from BIPs Student Enterprise Fairs):

- 7 Summer Camps with a total of 304 students and 66 teachers from 5 countries (BiH, Kosovo, Norway, Montenegro and Serbia) have participated.
